**SOLANGE KNOWLES TO DJ AT ALLEYBAR IN MONTGOMERY, ALABAMA ON SUNDAY,  
JANUARY 17, 2010 (MLK WEEKEND)**

MONTGOMERY, AL--- Before the dust could settle on the highly anticipated renovation of Montgomery's historic entertainment district, it has already begun to attract some of entertainment's Who's Who to the capital city. Preparing to make history as the first DJ to ever play at the Alley's newest establishment, the AlleyBAR, artist/singer/songwriter/actress/DJ Solange Knowles intends to rock the house by hosting and DJing "A Party" at the illustrious AlleyBAR on Sunday, January 17<sup>th</sup> at 9:00PM.

Inspired by Andy Warhol's "Exploding Plastic Inevitable", Beyoncé's younger sister, Solange, has begun hosting her own unique series of multimedia events in Houston, TX branded as "A Party". Solange's idea was inspired by multimedia events hosted by the world renowned Warhol that featured performances and screenings between 1966 and 1967. From the variety of music genres blasting from the speakers to the password-protected, quirky dress-code, dance-oriented theme, "A Party" targets the city's indie-music loving, multicultural, fashion-experimenting, hipster audience. With the success of "A Party" in Houston, Solange began looking to move the event into other cities. Friends and fellow music collaborators, the Bamaz a.k.a. the Bama Boyz, urged Solange to make A Party's first out-of-town stop in their hometown, Montgomery, AL.

The Bamaz are a music production/songwriting/artist trio originally from Montgomery, AL. They have been living in Houston, TX since 2003 after signing a major production deal with Mathew Knowles' Music World Entertainment. Solange Knowles and the Bamaz co-wrote many records together including "Valentine's Day" on Solange's latest album and the recently released bonus track "Why Don't You Love Me" appearing on Beyonce's new "I Am...Sasha Fierce" re-release. Solange and the Bamaz have teamed up with AlleyBAR to bring "A Party" to Montgomery, AL. Solange will DJ the event spinning a playlist of music reflecting indie, mainstream, and classic style with sample artists such as MGMT, Justice, Santogold, Marvin Gaye, Aaliyah, Lady GaGa, and Gucci. The Bamaz will perform a 45 minute live music set during which Solange walks amongst the crowd snapping polaroid pictures of the party's "Best Dressed" to feature on her blog, [mydamnblog.com](http://mydamnblog.com). Party goers will be required to give a password in order gain to entry into "A Party" at AlleyBAR.
